2010 LEGISLATIVE SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. The six criteria used to select the scholarship recipients are residence in the 7th district, academic standing, essay, letters of recommendation, school activities, and community activities. These criteria will be given appropriate weight in the selection process.
2. The deadline for receipt of completed applications at the district office is 4:00pm on **April 1, 2010**. This application should be mailed or delivered as follows: State Representative Karen A. Yarbrough, 2305 W. Roosevelt Road Broadview, IL 60155.
3. **The essay question also must be sent with the application package. It must be computer generated on 8 ½ x 11 inch white paper and should not exceed 750 words.**
4. You must include a copy of your most recent official transcripts with the application package. It must include your class size, class rank, grade point average, SAT and ACT scores (***if you are a high school student***).
5. **Two letters of reference must be sealed and mailed in the envelopes provided, separate from the application.** One letter must be from a teacher or administrator familiar with your academic abilities. These letters should reach the district office by **April 1, 2010**
6. State Representative Yarbrough will notify all students recommended for legislative scholarships. Applicants will be notified on the status of their application during May, 2010.
